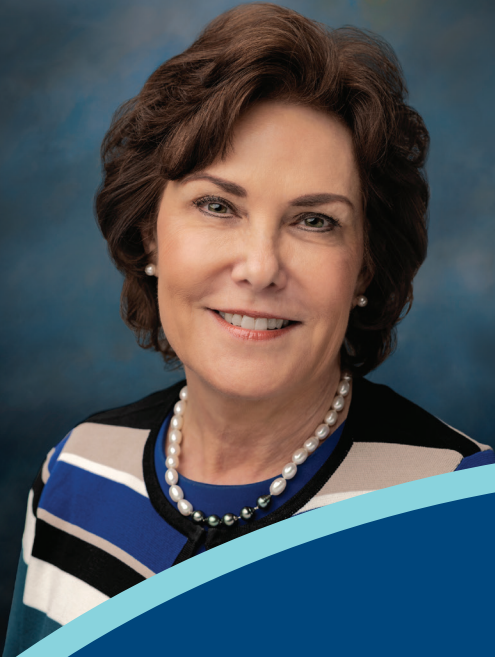

BILLS CHAMPIONED BY SENATOR ROSEN

Forever GI Bill: In the House, Rosen helped introduce this bipartisan bill, which allows veterans and their dependents to use their GI Bill benefits at any time in their lives. The bill was signed into law in 2017.

GI Bill Planning Act: Rosen introduced this bipartisan bill, which would give recruits 270 days to pick their preferred GI Bill benefits plan, instead of having to do so upon arrival at Basic Training.

Hire Student Veterans Act: Rosen introduced this bipartisan bill, which would expand the Work Opportunity Tax Credit to incentivize employers to hire student veterans.

Veterans Jobs Opportunity Act: Rosen introduced this bipartisan bill, which would provide a tax credit to veterans who open a small business in underserved communities.

Veterans Reimbursement for Emergency Ambulance Services Act: Rosen co-led this bipartisan bill, which would reimburse veterans for emergency ambulance services to non-VA facilities.

Blue Water Navy Vietnam Veterans Act of 2019: Rosen helped introduce this bipartisan bill, which extends benefits associated with Agent Orange exposure to veterans who served on ships off the coast of Vietnam during the war. This bill was signed into law.

Military Widow's Tax Elimination Act of 2019: Rosen co-sponsored this bipartisan bill, which repeals the Survivor Benefit Plan - Dependency and Indemnity Compensation offset, the so-called "widow's tax." This became law via the FY20 National Defense Authorization Act.

Burn Pits Accountability Act: Rosen helped introduce this bipartisan bill, which evaluates servicemembers' exposure to burn pits and toxic airborne chemicals during routine health exams. This became law via the FY20 National Defense Authorization Act.
