- Unmarried with no dependents
- At least 17, but less than 23 years of age by July 1 of the year you would enter

Congressional Nomination Required for Academy Admissions Package (Note: This is not required for the Coast Guard Academy)

Process involves submitting an online package and formal interview with the Nominations Board.

- Paperwork has to be uploaded to our portal.
- Nominations finalized and nominees informed in January.
- Nominations to specific Academies are limited and based on availability. The office can usually only nominate up to 10 deserving students to each Academy.
