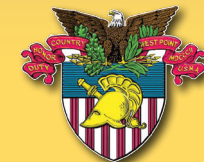

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to enter an Academy, you must be:

- A citizen of the United States
- Of good moral character
- Unmarried with no dependents
- At least 17, but less than 23 years of age by July 1 of the year you would enter

DEADLINE FOR ALL MATERIALS:
OCTOBER 31

Congressional Nomination Required for Academy Admissions Package
(Note: This is not required for the Coast Guard Academy)

Process involves submitting an online package and formal interview with the Nominations Board.

- Paperwork has to be uploaded to our portal.
- Nominations finalized and nominees informed in January.
- Nominations to specific Academies are limited and based on availability. The office can usually only nominate up to 10 deserving students to each Academy.

TIMELINE

Early Spring → Information Academy Day

May 1 → Application Portal opens

October 31 → Nomination Applications Due, Portal Closes

Mid-November → Nomination Interview Notification

Early December → Nomination Interview

Mid-January → Academy Nomination Decision

- 2 Letter of Interest to attend a Military Academy
- 3 Official High School Transcript
- 4 Two Recommendation Letters

NOMINATION FACTS AND FIGURES

- 40 nominations normally awarded to Nevada Students
 - ◆ United States Air Force Academy
 - ◆ United States Naval Academy
 - ◆ United States Military Academy
 - ◆ United States Merchant Marine Academy
- Nearly 100 applicants on average seek Senator Rosen's nomination
- 3.8 GPA average, standardized tests not counted
- Not all nominees are JROTC Cadets
- Multiple extracurricular activities are encouraged
- A strong track record is key, along with being well-rounded in and out of school
