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SOCIAL SECURITY

Social Security's retirement program has been an essential part of American life for over 85 years. In the following sections, you will find information from United States Social Security Administration (SSA) publications covering various topics. If you do not find the answers to your questions in this booklet, you can call the Social Security Administration to speak with them directly at **1-800-772-1213**.

SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFITS

You qualify for Social Security benefits by earning Social Security credits when you work a covered job and pay Social Security taxes. The Social Security Administration bases Social Security credits on the amount of your earnings. Social Security uses your earnings and work history to determine your eligibility for retirement or disability benefits or your family's eligibility for survivor benefits after a death. Each year the amount of earnings needed for credits goes up slightly as average earnings levels increase. The credits you earn remain on your Social Security record even if you change jobs or have no earnings for a while.

Your benefit amount is based on your earnings averaged over most of your working career. Higher lifetime earnings result in higher benefits.

RETIREMENT BENEFITS

At the Social Security Administration, people often ask, "What's the best age to start receiving retirement benefits?" The answer is that there's not a single "best age" for everyone and, ultimately, it's your choice. The most important thing is to make an informed decision. Base your decision about when to apply for benefits on your individual and family circumstances.

SUPPLEMENTAL SECURITY INCOME

What is Supplemental Security Income?

Supplemental Security Income (SSI) is an income assistance program run by the Social Security Administration. It provides monthly payments to blind individuals or people with disabilities who have little or no income and have not worked enough time to qualify as "insured" by Social Security standards. It also provides payments to people aged 65 and up without disabilities who meet specific financial requirements.

Individuals and couples are determined to be eligible if their countable income and resources do not exceed certain limits. SSI sets a minimum monthly income level and pays the difference between that figure and other income such as Social Security. SSI recipients can often qualify for Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), formerly known as food stamps, low-income housing, and other benefits.

People who have worked may also qualify to receive Social Security disability or retirement benefits in addition to SSI.

Since SSI payments can be reduced by other income, SSI applicants must apply for any other benefits for which they are eligible. Social Security works with claimants to help them receive any other benefits for which they are eligible. People who receive SSI checks can also receive Social Security benefits, if eligible.

SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (SNAP)

If you receive SSI, you may be able to get help through SNAP, formerly known as food stamps. SNAP benefits can help you buy more food without spending more money. However, the office of Senator Jacky Rosen *does not* decide if you qualify or not for SNAP benefits. If everyone in your household is applying for or receiving SSI, you can apply for SNAP at a Social Security office. If not, you must apply at your local county health or human services office.

The quickest and easiest way to apply for SNAP is online through Access Nevada or by calling the Nevada Division of Welfare and Supportive Services at 800-992-0900.

MEDICARE

Medicare is health insurance for Americans who are 65 or older. You are first eligible to sign up for Medicare three months before you turn 65. You may be eligible to enroll in Medicare earlier if you have End-Stage Renal Disease (ESRD), ALS (also called Lou Gehrig's disease), or have a qualified disability and as a result receive Social Security disability benefits.

Medicare is a federal program primarily administered by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). CMS and the Social Security Administration both handle some of the eligibility and application procedures, so you may sometimes receive Medicare-related mailings from SSA.

MEDICARE BASICS

Medicare offers different options for you to get health care coverage, including:



Part A (Hospital Insurance): Helps cover inpatient care in hospitals, skilled nursing facility care, hospice care, and home health care.



Part B (Medical Insurance): Helps cover:

- Services from doctors and other health care providers
- Outpatient care
- · Home health care
- Durable medical equipment (like wheelchairs, walkers, hospital beds, and other equipment)
- Many preventive services (like screenings, shots or vaccines, and annual "Wellness" visits)



Part D (Drug coverage): Helps cover the cost of many prescription drugs (including many recommended shots or vaccines). You can join a Medicare drug plan in addition to Original Medicare (Parts A and B), or you can get it by joining a Medicare Advantage Plan with drug coverage. Plans that offer Medicare drug coverage are run by private insurance companies that follow rules set by Medicare.



Medicare Supplemental Insurance (Medigap): Extra insurance you can buy from a private company that helps pay your share of costs in Original Medicare (Parts A and B). Policies are standardized, and in most states named by letters, like Plan G or Plan K. The benefits in each lettered plan are the same, no matter which insurance company sells it.

HELP WITH THE COST OF PRESCRIPTION DRUGS

Extra Help

Medicare beneficiaries can qualify for *Extra Help* paying for their monthly premiums, annual deductibles, and co-payments related to Medicare prescription drug coverage. The Social Security Administration estimates the Extra Help is worth about \$5,100 per year. To qualify for Extra Help, you must be receiving Medicare and have limited resources and income.

Medicaid is a joint federal and state program that provides health coverage to millions of Americans, including seniors and individuals with disabilities.

WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN MEDICARE AND MEDICAID?

Medicare is a medical insurance program for people over 65, in addition to younger people with disabilities, and dialysis patients. Medicaid is an assistance program for low-income patients' medical expenses.
