MEET SENATOR JACKY ROSEN

Rosen has lived in Nevada for nearly 40 years. As the first member of her family to graduate from college, Rosen worked two jobs and took out student loans to make ends meet. She worked as a waitress, including at Caesars Palace, and was a proud member of Culinary Workers Union Local 226. Before coming to Congress, Rosen built her career as a computer programmer and software developer for some of the biggest companies in Nevada. Rosen represented Nevada's Third District in the 115th Congress she was rated one of the most bipartisan House members. In 2018, Rosen was elected to the U.S. Senate, where she has championed early childhood education in STEM, especially for young girls. Rosen's bipartisan Building Blocks of STEM Act became law in December 2019. As a member of Congress, Rosen has worked tirelessly to protect health care coverage for those living with pre-existing conditions, create jobs for Nevadans, and help servicemembers find good-paying jobs after leaving the military.
