Thank you for expressing interest in **FEDERAL GRANTS**. I am confident that you will find value in this one-page grants resource guide as you embark on your journey to applying for grants. During 2022, my office helped secure more than \$1.1 billion for Nevada through federal grants and we are hoping to increase that number this year. To that end, my office can assist with the following services:

- **Congressional Letters of Support (LOS):** Some federal grant applications require or allow for letters of support. If you wish to request consideration of a LOS, visit [sen.gov/R184](https://sen.gov/R184).
- **Grant Award Tracking:** After you have applied for a specific federal grant, you may need to inquire about the status of your application with the respective federal awarding agency. My office is able to assist with this, when appropriate.
- **Grants Newsletter:** My office releases a monthly distribution that contains news about recently announced federal funding. Sign up at [rosen.senate.gov/grants-newsletter-signup](https://rosen.senate.gov/grants-newsletter-signup).
- **Webinars:** My office hosts quarterly webinars with federal agencies to discuss potential funding and assist grant seekers who may have questions about a specific federal agency and funding.
