FY2024 Community Project Funding for Nevada

Senators Rosen and Cortez Masto requested funding for projects in their communities to be included in the FY2024 omnibus funding agreement. The funding awarded to Nevada projects is listed below by subcommittee.

Agriculture, Rural Development: (5 total)

Nye County – Amargosa Library – \$750,000

The Library Extension project will add additional square footage to the existing library, helping to support the community's current and future needs.

<u>Douglas County - Smelter Creek Tributary Flood Control - \$55,000</u>

The Smelter Creek Tributary Flood Control project will construct a detention basin in order to alleviate downstream flooding impacts to the Ruhenstroth community.

<u>Duckwater Shoshone Tribe – Community Building – \$512,000</u>

The Community Building project will fund a community center in Duckwater for recreational, educational, social, and support services for the Tribe and community.

<u>Te-Moak Tribe of Western Shoshone, Elko Band – Indian View Heights Road</u> <u>Reconstruction – \$940,000</u>

The Indian View Heights Road Reconstruction project will provide funding to reconstruct and improve Indian View Heights, the main arterial roadway of the Elko Indian Colony.

Storey County – McCarran Sheriff's Office – \$450,000

The McCarran Sheriff's Office Substation project will relocate the County Sheriff's Office substation to the Storey County Government Complex located in McCarran, the north section of Storey County.

Commerce, Justice, and Science: (12 total)

<u>Clark County – Eighth Judicial District Court's Court Appointed Special Advocate</u> (CASA) – \$800,000

The Eighth Judicial District Court's Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) project will fund recruitment and training of court-appointed advocates. Funds would help expand awareness and recruitment of CASA volunteers to the program.

<u>Desert Research Institute (DRI) – Sustaining Planning for the Future at Lake</u> <u>Tahoe – \$3,000,000</u>

The Planning for the Future at Lake Tahoe project request will fund research focused on sustainable recreation and data aggregation for long-term planning at Lake Tahoe.

City of Ely – Security Cameras Installation Project – \$610,000

The Security Cameras Installation project will fund the installation of security cameras at the City of Ely's facilities and public parks.

<u>City of Henderson – Public Safety Officer Mental Health & Wellness Program –</u> \$782,000

This funding will expand the City of Henderson's wellness program for public safety professionals.

<u>Lander County - Crime Prevention Technology - \$563,000</u>

The Sheriff's Office Crime Prevention Technology project will fund the procurement of technology and equipment to support crime investigation, response, and prevention activities.

<u>Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department – Emergency Command Vehicle</u> <u>Replacement – \$1,000,000</u>

The Emergency Command Vehicle Replacement project will fund the replacement of an Emergency Command Vehicle to respond to large-scale emergencies.

City of North Las Vegas - Public Safety - \$1,620,000

The Public Safety Enhancement project will fund the procurement of outdated forensic technology, police bicycles, and various police vehicles.

<u>City of Reno – Police Department Wellness Initiatives – \$1,500,000</u>

The City of Reno will use this funding to support peer mentor mental health and wellness initiatives within the Reno Police Department.

<u>Reno Sparks Indian Colony – Law Enforcement Equipment – \$265,000</u> These funds will help Reno Sparks Indian Colony police officers upgrade to

These funds will help Reno Sparks Indian Colony police officers upgrade to equipment and patrol vehicles.

<u>City of Sparks – Police Security and Officer Safety – \$520,000</u>

The Sparks Police headquarters will use this funding to install new security equipment, cameras, and motion detector systems to improve officer safety.

<u>University of Nevada, Las Vegas – UNLV Analytical Equipment for Standardized</u> <u>Tectonic Measurement – \$982,000</u>

This project will fund the acquisition of analytical equipment for standardized tectonic measurement and to better support geoscience research.

Washoe County – Forensics and Rapid DNA – \$996,000

The Reno Police Department, Sparks Police Department, and the Washoe County Sheriff's Office will use these funds to purchase of Rapid DNA instruments as part of a pilot program.

Energy and Water Development: (2 total)

<u>Bureau of Reclamation – Lake Mead/Las Vegas Wash Program – \$3,500,000</u> The Bureau of Reclamation will construct erosion control structures along the Las Vegas Wash within the boundaries of the Lake Mead National Recreation Area.

<u>Desert Research Institute (DRI) – Lithium Resource Mapping – \$1,632,000</u> The Lithium Resource Mapping project will complete a comprehensive geologic mapping and study on lithium resources and recovery in Nevada.

Interior and Environment: (15 total)

City of Carlin – Arthur Spring Main Water Line Replacement - \$602,000 The Arthur Spring Main Water Line Replacement project will replace 3.56

The Arthur Spring Main Water Line Replacement project will replace 3,500 feet of the water transmission main pipeline between the primary spring water source and the water booster pump station located on Hamilton Street in Carlin.

<u>City of Ely – Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrade Project - \$4,815,000</u>

The Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrade Project will fund new equipment to address and correct deficiencies in the treatment process at the Ely Wastewater Treatment Plant.

<u>Fallon Paiute-Shoshone Tribe – Water Tank Replacement - \$186,000</u>

The Water Tank Replacement project will construct a new water storage tank to replace the existing, smaller water tank.

<u>Humboldt County -- Humboldt County for Grass Valley Waste Water Treatment</u> <u>Facility - \$2,750,000</u>

The Grass Valley Waste Water Treatment Facility project will help complete the design and engineering for a new wastewater treatment system in Grass Valley.

<u>Lyon County – Water Main Replacement- \$2,584,000</u>

The Grosh Water Main Replacement project will provide funding to design and replace a water distribution main located on Grosh Avenue in Dayton. This project will complete the final phase of the Rose Peak community water main replacement project.

Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe – Numana Dam Fish Screen - \$2,865,000

The Numana Dam Fish Screen Project will install a new fish screen and a pipe fixture at the headworks of the Numana Dam to prevent fish from entering water diverted for irrigation.

<u>City of Reno – Sewer Upgrades- \$3,000,000</u>

The Island 8 Septic to Sewer Conversion project will install sewer mains in the McCloud, Reno neighborhood and connect to the City of Reno sewer mains.

<u>Reno-Sparks Indian Colony – Cultural Resources/Tribal Historic Preservation</u> <u>Office Building Renovation - \$161,000</u>

The Cultural Resources/Tribal Historic Preservation Office Building Renovation project will fund the renovation of the Reno-Sparks Indian Colony's Cultural Resources Program and Tribal Historic Preservation Office Building in Reno.

<u>Southern Nevada Water Authority – Septic Conversion Phase One - \$959,757</u> The Septic Conversion project will assist community members with connecting homes currently utilizing septic systems to the public sewer system.

<u>Southern Nevada Water Authority – Septic Conversion Phase Two - \$959,752</u> The Septic Conversion project will assist community members with connecting homes currently utilizing septic systems to the public sewer system.

<u>Storey County – Sewer Collection System Replacement- \$2,500,000</u> The Gold Hill Collection System project will replace the existing gravity sewer collection system in the community of Gold Hill.

<u>Te-Moak Tribe of Western Shoshone, Battle Mountain Band – Water and Sewer Lines - \$2,000,000</u>

The Battle Mountain Band Water and Sewer Lines project will replace the existing water lines and sewer lines.

<u>Walker River Paiute Tribe – Water Storage Tank Improvements - \$1,362,000</u> The Water Storage Tank Improvements project will fund a new water storage tank and the repair of an existing water storage tank.

Washoe County - Stormwater Management Project - \$1,932,000

The Bailey Creek Stormwater Mitigation project will realign portions of Bailey Creek Park's drainage infrastructure to improve hydraulic flow, armoring, and utility relocation.

<u>West Wendover – 3 Mile Reservoir Rehabilitation - \$209,000</u>

The 3 Mile Reservoir Rehabilitation project will fund the rehabilitation of the 3 Mile Reservoir, a 1.5-million-gallon enclosed drinking water storage facility located within the Goshute Valley.

Military Construction and Veterans Affairs (4 total)

Nellis Air Force Base – Dormitory: Planning and Design – \$7,500,000

To fund project and development (P&D) design of a 240-room dormitory at Nellis Air Force Base to enable future years appropriations for construction.

<u>Nevada Army National Guard Combined Support Maintenance Shop: Planning and Design – \$2,700,000</u>

To fund project and development (P&D) design of a Combined Support Maintenance Shop in North Las Vegas to enable future years appropriations for construction.

<u>Nevada Army National Guard – General Instruction Facility: Planning and</u> <u>Design – \$5,490,000</u>

To fund project and development (P&D) design of a Regional Training Institute facility in North Las Vegas to enable future years appropriations for construction.

<u>Nevada Army National Guard - Ready Building: Planning and Design - \$590,000</u> To fund project and development (P&D) design of a Ready Building in Reno for a

To fund project and development (P&D) design of a Ready Building in Reno for a team of first responders in the event of a chemical, biological, radiological, or nuclear attack to enable future years appropriations for construction.

Transportation, Housing, and Urban Development: (37 total)

<u>Carson City - Road Widening and Enhancement Project along Curry Street</u>— \$2,600,000

The Curry Street Complete Streets Improvement project will widen Curry Street to include bike lanes, new pedestrian connections, enhanced street lighting, and additional stormwater infrastructure.

<u>Clark County – Lutheran Social Services of Nevada Journey Senior Services</u> Center–\$1,616,279

Clark County's Lutheran Social Services of Nevada (LSSN) Journey Senior Services Center project request will be used by Clark County to expand and construct a dining hall, commercial kitchen, and office space at a senior social services center.

<u>Clark County Department of Aviation – Henderson Airport Terminal Building</u> Remodeling – \$2,200,000

The Henderson Executive Airport Terminal Expansion project will remodel and expand the existing terminal building at Henderson Executive Airport (HND) to improve the capacity and energy efficiency of the airport.

<u>Clark County Department of Aviation – Reconstruct the Airfield Rescue and Fire</u> Fighting (ARFF) Station–\$1,000,000

The project will bring the Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting (ARFF) facilities at Harry Reid International Airport up to the current safety, operational, and environmental standards.

<u>City of Ely – Campton Street Improvement – \$893,000</u>

The Campton Street Improvement will install streetlights, a sidewalk, curbs, and gutters in downtown Ely.

<u>City of Fallon – New River Substation Backup Generator – \$3,640,000</u>

The New River Substation Backup Generator will help install a generator to allow partial power to be supplied to the City during extended outages and allow for supplemental generation during peak periods.

City of Fallon – Kaiser Road Reconstruction – \$4,900,000

The Kaiser Street Reconstruction project will improve roadways and sidewalks to increase safety and access for pedestrians.

Fallon Paiute-Shoshone Tribe – Stillwater Senior Center – \$180,000

The Stillwater Senior Center project will fund new vehicles and equipment for the Tribe's senior center to enhance the quality of life services to Native American Elders.

<u>Town of Gardnerville – Reconstruction of Industrial Way – \$1,260,000</u>

The Southgate Industrial Park Road Restoration project will restore pavement in the Town of Gardnerville's second largest industrial area.

<u>City of Henderson – Navigation Center – \$4,000,000</u>

The Navigation Center project will fund the acquisition of a building for a new Navigation Center to serve those experiencing or at risk of homelessness.

<u>City of Henderson – Prototype Park, City of Henderson, Clark County, Nevada –</u> \$500,000

The Wells Park Renovation project will redevelop Wells Park in the historic Pittman neighborhood and provide a park design that addresses water conservation and sustainability.

<u>Lander County – Installation of ADA Compliant Pedestrian Access Facilities–</u> \$2,843,000

The Safe Route to Schools project will install ADA-compliant pedestrian access facilities in Battle Mountain.

<u>City of Las Vegas – High Injury Network Streetlight Safety Upgrades – \$2,500,000</u> The Streetlight Safety Upgrade project will fund the procurement and installation of over 3,500 upgraded streetlights to improve safety for all modes of transportation in corridors where traffic incidents are high.

<u>City of Las Vegas - Vision Zero Program Implementation - \$5,000,000</u>

The project will fund pedestrian and bike facilities enhancements, median island modifications, traffic signal and street lighting upgrades, and pavement rehabilitation. These countermeasures will improve transportation safety along roadways in order to reduce traffic fatalities and serious injuries.

Las Vegas Paiute Tribe – Blight Removal – \$550,000

The Blight Removal project will fund major landscaping at the entrance to the Tribe's downtown Reservation.

<u>Lyon County - Miller and Aiazzi Intersection Alignment – \$2,200,000</u> The Miller and Aiazzi Intersection Realignment project will rebuild the intersection of Miller Lane and Aiazzi Lane to improve public safety.

<u>Nevada Department of Transportation – Improvements on US 93 and SR 173, Henderson and Boulder City, Nevada – \$1,000,000</u>

The I-11/SR 173/US 93 Rehabilitation project will rehabilitate aging pavement and upgrade existing hydraulic drainage facilities in the corridor to provide better resiliency during storm events.

<u>Nevada Department of Transportation – I-95 Rehabilitation – \$1,000,000</u> The I-95 Rehabilitation project will rehabilitate existing aging pavement and update hydraulic drainage facilities and existing access points onto the roadway.

<u>Nevada Department of Transportation – Pyramid Way (SR 445) – \$1,000,000</u> The Pyramid Way (SR 445) project will rehabilitate the pavement and upgrade existing ramps, driveways, and sidewalks up to ADA standards. The project will also upgrade traffic signal systems, install fiber conduit for traffic signal synchronization, and install new Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon.

<u>Nevada Department of Transportation – Red Rock Canyon Trail Improvements –</u> \$1,000,000

The State Route 159 Pedestrian and Bicycle Pathway project will help construct a shared-use path for pedestrians and bicyclists to the Red Rock Canyon National Conservation Areas, while also addressing safety and operational concerns at two major intersections.

<u>Nevada Department of Transportation – State Route 227 Roundabout – \$5,000,000</u> The State Route 227 project will fund the construction of a roundabout that will help manage traffic flow and reduce risks of vehicle collisions.

<u>Nevada Department of Transportation – US 95 Pavement Preservation and Safety Improvements on US 95 South of I-11 near Boulder City, Nevada – \$1,000,000</u> The US 95 Pavement Preservation project will improve a mill, overlay, and other roadway infrastructure to support desert tortoises and their habitat and enhance driver safety.

City of North Las Vegas – Cheyenne Park – \$6,760,000

The Cheyenne Park Safety and Activity project will add critical safety elements, activity centers, and a park maintenance hub to provide a variety of health benefits to low and moderate-income area residents.

City of North Las Vegas – Dolores Huerta Resource Center – \$1,616,279

The Dolores Huerta Resource Center project will fund a one-stop-shop to provide services to the large Hispanic community in North Las Vegas. Services will include legal services, education, workforce development training, arts and culture, physical and mental health support, and technology training.

City of North Las Vegas – Fire Training Facility – \$1,000,000

The Fire Training Facility project will fund the purchase of a modular structure to house a classroom and offices to train firefighters.

Nye County - Pogue Summit Road Paving Project - \$4,393,000

The Pogue Summit Road Paving project will be used to pave 13 miles of Pogue Summit Road in Nye County.

City of Reno – Rehabilitation for Historic California Building – \$870,000

The Rehabilitation for Historic California Building project will fund renovations to the interior and exterior of the City of Reno's historic California Building.

<u>City of Reno – Solar School Zone Flashing Beacon Systems Installation –</u> \$1,000,000

The School Zone Flashing Beacons Systems project will fund the installation of solar-powered school zone flashers in 56 school zones to improve safety.

Reno-Sparks Indian Colony – Sunshine Lane Site Preparation – \$1,621,000

The Sunshine Lane Site Preparation project will help fund site clearance and fence installation for future development of government offices, cultural center, and court and justice facilities for the Reno-Sparks Indian Colony.

<u>Reno Tahoe Airport Authority – Airport Rescue & Firefighting Apparatus</u> <u>Replacement – \$911,000</u>

The Airport Rescue & Firefighting Apparatus Replacement project will allow the Reno-Tahoe Airport Authority to purchase a new Aircraft Rescue and Firefighting (ARFF) vehicle.

<u>Regional Transportation Commission (RTC) of Southern Nevada – Advanced</u> Public Transit Driver Assistance Part One - \$850,000

The Advanced Public Transit Driver Assistance project will fund the installation of video mirrors on 425 fixed route transit vehicles to improve roadway safety.

<u>Regional Transportation Commission (RTC) of Southern Nevada – Advanced</u> Public Transit Driver Assistance Part Two – \$500,000

The Advanced Public Transit Driver Assistance project will fund the installation of video mirrors on 425 fixed route transit vehicles to improve roadway safety.

<u>Regional Transportation Commission (RTC) of Southern Nevada – North Las</u> <u>Vegas Carey Avenue – \$1,920,000</u>

The North Las Vegas Carey Avenue project will rehabilitate and replace damaged and failing asphalt concrete, install new LED streetlights and pedestrian crossings, and relocate utilities.

<u>Regional Transportation Commission (RTC) of Washoe County - Sun Valley</u> Boulevard Corridor Improvements Phase 2 – \$2,500,000

The Sun Valley Boulevard Corridor Improvements Phase 2 project will fund pedestrian, bicycle, transit, and traffic safety improvements within the corridor, primarily through reconfiguration of the existing right-of-way from Scottsdale Road to 7th Avenue.

<u>City of Sparks – Sparks Street Pedestrian Rehabilitation Project – \$1,372,000</u> The Street Pedestrian Concrete Rehabilitation project will replace failing curbs, gutters, sidewalks, and driveway approaches in a residential community near Kate Smith Elementary School in Sparks.

<u>City of Sparks – The Oddie Boulevard Community Center Project – \$4,000,000</u> The Oddie Boulevard Community Center Project will fund building improvements and renovations to create a community service center with childcare space, workforce training opportunities, community education, and meeting spaces. <u>Tahoe Transportation District - State Route 28 Central Corridor - \$5,000,000</u> The State Route 28 Central Corridor project will complete construction of two lot expansions between Sand Harbor to Thunderbird Cove to remove vehicles from the highway shoulder and connect them with a section of Class I trail for public use.

<u>City of West Wendover – Downtown Development and Infrastructure – \$3,710,000</u> The Downtown Development Infrastructure Phase 2 project will fund construction of a utility and public restroom facility and community splash pad within the Victory Plaza located in the city's downtown area.
