

FY2026 Community Project Funding for Nevada

Senator Rosen and Senator Cortez Masto requested funding for projects in their communities to be included in the FY2026 appropriations bills. The funding awarded to Nevada projects is listed below by subcommittee.

Subcommittee on Agriculture, Rural Development, Food and Drug Administration, and Related Agencies:

Ely Shoshone Tribe – Community Facility Center - \$3,100,000

The Ely Shoshone Tribe's Community Facility Center project will fund a Community Facility for recreational, educational, social, and support & health services for the Ely Shoshone Tribe and community.

Subcommittee on Commerce, Justice, Science:

Carson City Sheriff's Office – Rapid DNA Instrument - \$450,000

The Carson City Sheriff's Office's (CCSO) Rapid DNA Instrument project will use funding to purchase a Rapid DNA instrument for the CCSO to help bolster law enforcement efficiency, improve community outcomes, and assist in easing the workload in Nevada's State Crime Lab.

City of Ely – First Responder Communication Equipment Upgrades - \$5,000,000

The First Responder Communication Equipment Upgrade project would use funds to purchase technology and upgrade a new 9-1-1 dispatch system that would significantly improve safety and response times for White Pine County residents and visitors.

Lincoln County Sheriff's Office – Computer Aided Dispatch - \$531,000

The Lincoln County Sheriff Office's Computer Aided Dispatch Project will use funds to replace the Office's outdated record management system in order to improve response times, enhance officer safety, and improve data accuracy.

Washoe County – Northern Nevada Mobile Intelligence Response Vehicle - \$3,000,000

Washoe County's Mobile Intelligence Response Vehicle project will use funds to acquire a Mobile Command Intelligence Vehicle (MCIV) for emergency preparedness and response.

City of Reno – Real Time Information Center Project - \$1,200,000

The Real Time Information Center (RTIC) project will fund equipment and software to establish Reno Police Department's Public Safety Center. The Center will fully embrace intelligence-led policing, provide enhanced information for response to calls for service, and increase investigatory capability and overall public safety.

City of Fallon – Dispatch and Emergency Response Communication System - \$1,000,000

The City of Fallon's Dispatch and Emergency Response Communication System project will use funding to modernize the Fallon Police Department Dispatch and Emergency Response Communication Network and Records Management System to achieve multi-agency compliance and interoperability with emergency responders throughout the State of Nevada.

Nye County – Security Enhancements Project - \$1,031,000

Nye County's Security Enhancements project will use funding to install security cameras at county facilities and public parks.

Nevada State Police – Virtual Reality Law Enforcement Training - \$360,000

The Nevada State Police's Virtual Reality Law Enforcement Training Project will fund hardware and training software devices for a virtual reality (VR) training system to allow officers to train on handling a wide array of scenarios.

Lyon County – Mobile Crisis Response Co-Responder Vehicle - \$90,000

Lyon County's Mobile Crisis Response Vehicle project will fund the purchase and retrofit of one law enforcement vehicle for Lyon County Human Services and the Lyon County Sheriff's Department's Mobile Outreach Safety Team (MOST).

Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department – Air Support Equipment Enhancement - \$1,031,000

The Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department will use funds to procure equipment needed to support flight operations for search and rescue, routine patrols, and large-scale event security.

City of Henderson – Crisis Negotiation Command Vehicle - \$750,000

The City of Henderson's Crisis Negotiation Command Vehicle project will use funds to acquire a new, streamlined Crisis Negotiation Command Vehicle (CNCV) to function as the Henderson Police Department's primary mobile command vehicle.

City of Henderson – Domestic Violence Response - \$1,031,000

The City of Henderson's Domestic Violence Response project will use funds to implement a comprehensive anti-violence initiative focused on improving training for police officers and prosecutors, providing qualified, consistent forensic examinations, and providing intervention services for victims of domestic violence (DV) and sexual assault (SA).

Subcommittee on Energy and Water Development:

U.S. Army Corps of Engineers / Big Bend Water District – Laughlin, Section 219, NV - \$908,000

Big Bend Water District's Laughlin Water Infrastructure project will use funding to complete the design phase for the first of 2 two-million-gallon storage tanks for potable water for the town of Laughlin, Nevada.

University of Nevada, Las Vegas – Nuclear Magnetic Resonance - \$1,950,000

University of Nevada, Las Vegas will use funds to support the acquisition of a Nuclear Magnetic Resonance (NMR) spectrometer to advance nuclear energy and actinide research and development.

Subcommittee on Financial Services and General Government:

Northern Nevada Development Authority – Northern Nevada Center of Excellence Small Business Incubator - \$1,000,000

Northern Nevada Development Authority's Northern Nevada Center of Excellence Small Business Incubator project will use funds for a small business incubator at the Northern Nevada Center of Excellence. The Small Business Incubator will support local small businesses, entrepreneur training, counseling, and research.

University of Nevada, Reno – Repository of Tribal Cultural Artifacts - \$442,000

The Repository of Tribal Cultural Artifacts project will use funding to gather documents, categorize, and digitize discovered Tribal cultural artifacts for the Office of Indigenous Relations at the University of Nevada, Reno.

Desert Research Institute – Southern Nevada Historic Preservation Project - \$558,000

Desert Research Institute's Southern Nevada Historic Preservation project will use funds to help preserve and archive key Nevada archeological files to create digital archival records. Funds will also be used to acquire new scanners to ensure lasting capability for the archive, and external solid-state drives will be acquired to hold the scans.

Subcommittee on Interior and Environment:

City of Baker – Water Infrastructure Upgrades - \$3,871,000

The City of Baker Water Infrastructure Upgrades project will use funds to upgrade the community's water and wastewater mains, laterals, and service lines.

City of Sparks – Water Reclamation Backup Power Systems - \$3,773,000

Funds for phase one design and construction services to ultimately acquire backup power systems for the Truckee Meadows Water Reclamation Facility.

Lyon County – Generator Project - \$240,000

Lyon County's Well 21 Generator Project will use funds to purchase and install a 750KW generator at Well 21 in Dayton, Nevada.

Virgin Valley Water District – Interstate 15 (I-15) Pipe Replacement Project - \$1,616,000

This project will use funds to replace approximately 2,000 feet of transmission line of failed/undersized pipe the runs beneath Interstate 15 in two locations (from the Freeway Tank on the north side of I-15 to historic Mesquite on the south side of I-15; and at the Nevada/Arizona state border).

Nevada Division of Water Resources – Nevada Water Initiative Phase II - \$1,500,000

This project will use funds to apply new science and techniques to develop ground water availability information and water resource management tools in the Carson Desert and South-Central Marshes groundwater basins.

Lyon County – Sewer Rehabilitation Project - \$1,937,766

Lyon County's Sewer Main and Manhole Rehabilitation project will use funds to rehabilitate and replace gravity sewer lines, and rehabilitate and replace manholes in the old town area of Dayton, NV.

City of Fernley – Water Treatment Plant Upgrade - \$2,000,000

The City of Fernley's Surface Water Treatment Integration project will use funds for the engineering and construction of facility upgrades at the Fernley Water Treatment Facility.

City of West Wendover – Water Transmission System Pipeline Replacement - \$2,000,000

The City of West Wendover's Water Transmission System Pipeline Replacement project will use funds to replace 5,400 feet of 24-inch pre-stressed concrete cylinder pipe.

City of Elko – Water Storage Tank Reconstruction - \$2,000,000

The City of Elko's Water Storage Tank Rehabilitation project will use funds to pay for the construction costs associated with rehabilitating a three million gallon water storage tank.

Gardnerville GID – Pipeline Replacement Project - \$2,000,000

The South District Pipeline Replacement Program will fund a water mains upgrade in Gardnerville.

Reno-Sparks Indian Colony – Water Treatment Facility Design and Engineering - \$2,224,000

Reno-Sparks Indian Colony's Water Pipeline Engineering and Design project will use funds for the engineering and design of a potable water pipeline from Lemmon Valley to the Hungry Valley Reservation, including route planning, sizing, and construction drawings.

City of North Las Vegas – Losee Wash Diversion Project - \$1,092,000

The City of North Las Vegas' Losee Wash Diversion Project will fund the construction of a relief to limit sanitary sewer overflows and provide additional capacity to develop north and northwest portions of the city.

Clark County Water Reclamation District – Wastewater Treatment Facility Project - \$1,092,000

Clark County Water Reclamation District's Indian Springs Sewer Construction project will use funds for the construction of a sewer replacement and a 15-inch gravity sewer main to serve the Indian Springs Community.

Moapa Valley Water District – Water Transmission Line Project - \$1,092,000

Moapa Valley Water District's 24-Inch Pipeline Replacement project will use funds to replace approximately 4.3 miles (22,600 feet) of a critical length of existing 24-inch potable water transmission line that has experienced a high leak/break rate.

Las Vegas Valley Water District – New Rainbow Discharge Line - \$1,092,000

The Las Vegas Valley Water District's New Rainbow Discharge Line project will use funds for the replacement and rerouting of the current discharge pipeline.

Virgin Valley Water District – Main Transmission Line Replacement - \$1,092,000

The Virgin Valley Water District will use funds to replace approximately 26,000 feet of failed/failing/undersized transmission lines (pipe, valves, tees, and other appurtenances) on Riverside Road and White Rock Road.

Clark County Water Reclamation District – Laughlin Lift Station No. 2 Replacement - \$1,092,000

Clark County Water Reclamation District's Laughlin Lift Station No. 2 project will use funds to construct 11,250 feet of two new 16-inch diameter force mains to restore operational reliability, construct a maintenance access road along the alignment, and rehabilitate the existing gravity sewer line.

City of Boulder City – Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrades - \$980,000

Boulder City's Wastewater Treatment Plant Reliability Upgrade project will use funds to upgrade the wastewater treatment plant's foundation and floor, grade the basins, and upgrade PVC liners.

Subcommittee on Labor, Health and Human Services, and Education, and Related Agencies:

City of Carlin Volunteer Fire Department – Cardiac Monitors - \$98,000

The City of Carlin Volunteer Fire Department’s Cardiac Monitors project will use funds to acquire cardiac monitors for transport ambulances.

City of Wells – Hybrid Medical Clinic Expansion - \$227,000

The City of Wells’ Hybrid Medical Clinic Expansion project will use funds to expand services at the Wells Medical Clinic, combining both telehealth and in-person physical care.

Nevada State University – Juvenile Health Center Clinical Equipment - \$2,000,000

Nevada State University’s (NSU) Juvenile Health Center Clinical Equipment project will use funds to pay for clinical equipment for a new health education center and clinic providing medical care to young people.

Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe – Tribal Health Clinic Expansion - \$4,000,000

The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe’s Tribal Health Clinic Expansion project will use funds to address current clinical space deficiencies and lay the groundwork for expanded health services.

University of Nevada, Las Vegas – Nursing Education Innovation - \$2,398,000

The University of Nevada Las Vegas’ Nursing Education Innovation project will use funds to buy clinical simulation training equipment for undergraduate and graduate students in the university’s Nursing Clinical Simulation program.

University of Nevada, Reno – School of Medicine Cancer Research Center - \$3,049,000

The University of Nevada, Reno’s School of Medicine Cancer Research Center project will use funds for the planning and design of, site prep for, and demolition activities related to, the creation of a new Cancer Research Center.

Carson City School District – MTSS and Mental Health Wellness Project - \$301,000

Carson City School District’s (CCSD) Student MTSS and Mental Health Wellness project will use funds to hire an Engagement and Attendance Specialist and a Mental Health Services Project Coordinator. Funds will also be used for Licensed Social Workers’ contract hours and a one-year subscription to Care Solace.

Nevada Department of Education – Nevada Student Trauma Recovery Project - \$567,000

The Nevada Department of Education’s Nevada Student Trauma Recovery project will use funds to provide outpatient trauma-specific mental health treatment for eligible Nevada preschool, elementary, and secondary students who have experienced trauma and subsequently demonstrate academic, behavioral, attendance, or other issues at school.

University of Nevada, Las Vegas – Holocaust and Genocide Studies - \$700,000

The University of Nevada Las Vegas’ Holocaust and Genocide Studies project will use funds to increase access to Holocaust and Genocide studies in Nevada.

College of Southern Nevada – Firefighter Workforce Training Technology - \$305,000

The College of Southern Nevada’s Fire Technology project will use funds to purchase tools and equipment, including hoses, protective gear, fire engines, and training props for firefighter workforce training.

Nevada Governor's Office of Economic Development (GOED) – Talent Retention Program - \$4,530,000

Nevada Governor's Office of Economic Development (GOED) Talent Retention Program project will use funds to extend the UNLV StepUp & StartUp ("SUSU") Internship Program for engineering, science, and business students in order to enhance workforce retention.

University of Nevada, Las Vegas – Educator Apprenticeships Program - \$2,817,000

The University of Nevada Las Vegas' Educator Apprenticeships program will use funds to establish registered educator apprenticeship consortiums to address the critical shortage of teacher professionals.

Western Nevada College – Culinary Workforce Training Equipment and Education Project - \$1,450,000

Western Nevada College's (WNC) Culinary Workforce Training Equipment and Education project will use funds for equipment and supplies, as well as related retrofitting costs, to accommodate new equipment for a culinary workforce training education program. Funds will also be used to update the culinary curriculum.

Subcommittee on Military Construction, Veterans Affairs, and Related Agencies:

Nevada Air National Guard – Fuel Cell Hangar - \$5,400,000

To fund planning and design (P&D) of a larger fuel cell hangar. This project will provide a larger facility to enable extensive maintenance to occur on the fuel system of the C-130H by providing sufficient nose and tail clearance for the aircraft. This project is necessary for the Wing to be eligible to host C-130Js, which are larger than C-130Hs.

Nellis Air Force Base – Regional Communications Center - \$4,000,000

To fund the planning and design (P&D) of a Regional Communications Center at Nellis AFB to enable future years appropriations for construction. This project will replace a degrading building built in 1953, which will serve as the communications focal point for Nellis AFB, Creech AFB, and the Nevada Test and Training Range, and empower services tied to mission essential functions.

Nellis Air Force Base – F-35 Data Lab Support Facility - \$2,000,000

To fund the planning and design (P&D) of an F-35 Data Lab Support Facility at Nellis AFB to enable future years appropriations for construction. Nellis AFB is the central F-35 Data Lab for the F-35 Joint Program Office and provides services to the operational test community throughout the nation. As the program has matured the demands for the data lab have exponentially increased along with the data processing expectations. The current Data Lab facility has maximized production within its existing floor plan, and can no longer keep up with these demands. A new facility will allow for an increase in manpower and improved Data Lab capabilities for this critical mission.

Subcommittee on Transportation, Housing and Urban Development, and Related Agencies

Reno-Tahoe Airport Authority – Terminal Improvements - \$2,000,000

Reno-Tahoe Airport Authority's Concourse Development project will use funds to procure and install flooring within the apron and concourse levels of two buildings and procure new seating for holdrooms.

Clark County Department of Aviation – Reconstruct the ARFF Station at LAS Phase 2 to Reconstruct the Airfield Rescue and Fire Fighting Station at LAS Airport - \$1,100,000 (across two projects)

The LAS Airport Airfield Rescue and Fire Fighting Facility Reconstruction project will use funds to bring the Airfield Rescue and Fire Fighting (ARFF) facilities at Harry Reid International Airport (LAS), Nevada's busiest commercial airport, up to current standards.

Nevada Department of Transportation – US 93 Safety Enhancements - \$2,000,000

Nevada Department of Transportation's US 93 Safety Enhancement project will use funds for shoulder widening; installation of technology to improve operational communications; construction of passing lanes, truck climbing lanes, and centerline rumble strips; and improvements of shoulder slopes and guardrail end terminals for a portion of US 93 in Wells, Nevada.

Nevada Department of Transportation – US 6 in White Pine County - \$2,000,000

Nevada Department of Transportation's US 6 in White Pine County project will use funds for milling and filling, pavement preservation, shoulder widening, and installation of technology to improve operation communications.

Nevada Department of Transportation – US 6 Tonopah Downtown Restoration - \$850,000

Nevada Department of Transportation's US 6 Tonopah Downtown Rehabilitation project will use funds for roadway reconstruction to promote safer travel speeds, construction of a new storm drain system, installation of technology to improve operational communications, and complete street elements.

Nevada Department of Transportation – SR 596 Jones Blvd Preservation - \$250,000

Nevada Department of Transportation's SR 596 Jones Blvd Preservation project will use funds for road construction between W. Sahara Ave and US 95 Interchange on SR 596 Jones Blvd.

City of Las Vegas – Revitalizing Bonanza Road for Safer Mobility - \$250,000

The City of Las Vegas' Bonanza Road Safety Improvements project will use funds for design and environmental review for safety improvements on Bonanza Rd. from Rancho Dr. to MLK Jr. Blvd.

City of Las Vegas – CC-215 Trail Bridges at Summerlin Parkway - \$1,200,000

The City of Las Vegas' Trail Bridges at Summerlin Parkway project will use funds for construction of two steel-fabricated trail bridges and supporting infrastructure at Sunset Run Dr. and Sky Vista Dr. to connect and extend the existing CC-215 Beltway Trail.

Nevada Department of Transportation – SR 159 Preservation - \$2,000,000

Nevada Department of Transportation's SR 159 Preservation project will use funds to renovate roadways and provide safety along a road heavily utilized by visitors to the Red Rock National Conservation Area.

City of Las Vegas – Vision Zero School Zone Safety Improvements - \$1,600,000 (across two projects)

The City of Las Vegas' Vision Zero School Zone Safety Improvements project will use funding to upgrade existing school flasher systems citywide to improve school zone safety and system reliability while minimizing system maintenance.

Nevada Department of Transportation – SR 147 Improvements - \$1,000,000

The SR 147 Lake Mead Blvd Improvements project will use funds for seven miles of road construction and preservation east of North Pecos Rd on State Route 157 Lake Mead Blvd.

Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada – Nevada Way Rehabilitation Project - \$850,000

The Nevada Way Rehabilitation Project will fund the reconstruction of Nevada Way from Wyoming Street to Park Street through Boulder City’s historic downtown area, and also fund the reconstruction of Park Street from Nevada Way to Colorado Street/Utah Street.

Nevada Department of Transportation – Charleston Boulevard Preservation - \$1,200,000

The Charleston Blvd SR 159 Preservation project will use funds for road construction from Boulder Highway to Nellis Blvd on Charleston Blvd.

City of Henderson – Via Nobilia Interchange Project - \$5,000,000

The City of Henderson’s Via Nobilia Interchange project will use funds for the construction of the Via Nobilia and I-15 interchange.

Tahoe Transportation District – Sand Harbor Multi-Use Trail Project - \$5,000,000

Tahoe Transportation District’s Sand Harbor multi-use Trail project will use funds for the construction of a shared use path for bicycles and pedestrians in order to improve road safety and increase access to a scenic byway.

Nevada Department of Transportation – US 50A Fernley Cottonwood Roundabout - \$2,000,000

Nevada Department of Transportation’s US 50A Fernley Cottonwood Roundabout project will use funds for the construction of a roundabout in Fernley to improve the efficient flow of traffic at an increasingly congested intersection.

Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada – RTC Dual Direction Bus Shelters - \$1,350,000 (across three projects)

The Heat-Resistant Bus Shelters project will fund construction and installation of 120 heat-resistant bus shelters throughout the transit system, utilizing features to improve comfort, convenience, safety, and accessibility for passengers in Southern Nevada.

Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada – Transit Infrastructure Safety Improvements - \$3,000,000

Regional Transportation Commission (RTC) of Southern Nevada’s Transit Infrastructure Safety Improvements project will use funds to upgrade, replace and install lighting systems at 800 bus shelters throughout the RTC service area in the Las Vegas Valley.

Regional Transportation Commission of Washoe County – Roadway and Pedestrian Walkway Improvements - \$6,000,000

RTC of Washoe County’s Local Street Pavement Rehabilitation project will use funds for pavement rehabilitation and pedestrian improvement projects in three neighborhoods.

Carson City Public Works – 5th Street Roundabout Project - \$3,000,000

Carson City’s 5th Street Roundabout Improvement project will use funds to address safety and congestion challenges at an intersection by enhancing an existing roundabout, which is crucial to prevent flooding and preserve the natural environment.

Clark County – Energy Resilience and Safety Project - \$500,000 (across two projects)

Clark County's Energy Resilience and Safety Project will use funds to remove and replace outdoor metal halide lighting fixtures and replace them with LED fixtures in order to enhance safety and visibility.

Lyon County – Mound House Community Center - \$600,000

Lyon County's Mound House Community Center project will use funds to remodel an old fire station to become a community center for the residents of Mound House.

City of North Las Vegas – Library Expansion - \$2,500,000

The City of North Las Vegas' Library Expansion project will use funds to support the renovation and modernization of a library, providing access to technology, job training, and early literacy programs for underserved residents.

City of West Wendover – Community Center - \$7,796,000

The City of West Wendover's Community Center project will use funds to complete the final engineering design and construction of a community center.

Lander County – Assisted Living Center - \$250,000

Lander County's Assisted Living Center project will use funds to construct a county-owned and operated assisted living facility to provide safe, comfortable housing for local seniors.

Elko County – Specialty Court Housing Program - \$635,000

Elko County's Specialty Court Housing project will use funds for planning, permitting and construction costs to provide temporary, supportive housing for young individuals who are transitioning from juvenile detention facilities or aging out of the juvenile system.

City of Las Vegas – Historic Westside Community Land Trust Affordable Housing - \$1,850,000

The City of Las Vegas' Historic Westside Community Land Trust Affordable Housing project will use funds to support the construction of five affordable homes and ensure that homeownership remains accessible for local families.

City of Reno – Community Center Wellness Project - \$3,000,000

The City of Reno's Community Center Wellness project will modify the north wing of the City of Reno's Evelyn Mount Northeast Community Center facility to allow increased capacity and essential mental health and wellness services for underserved community members.

City of Las Vegas – Homelessness Prevention and Diversion Program - \$1,000,000

The City of Las Vegas' Homelessness Prevention & Diversion project will use funds to provide financial assistance to individuals and families at risk of homelessness, covering rent, utility arrears, and prospective rent to prevent eviction.
